

SPAY & NEUTER PROGRAMS

The Concord-Merrimack County SPCA strongly urges all pet owners to have their pets spayed and neutered to help with overpopulation and prevent the birth of unwanted animals. Spaying and neutering will also help your pets live longer and healthier lives.

NH Animal Population Control Program- Plan A

Available to: NH residents when they adopt a cat or dog from a licensed NH animal shelter.

Costs: Base fee for the surgery is \$40.00. This **only** covers the surgery itself and does not cover other procedures such as pre-surgery bloodwork or immunizations. Please call your veterinarian to discuss any additional fees they may charge.

NH Animal Population Control Program- Plan B

Available to: NH residents who receive, or are eligible for, benefits from one of the following state assistance programs-

Food Stamps	Medicaid
Aid to the Needy Blind	Old Age Assistance
Supplemental Security Income (SSI)	AFDC
Aid to the Permanently and Totally Disabled	

Costs: Base fee is \$25.00. This will include a rabies and distemper vaccination if needed. Please call the veterinarian to discuss any additional fees they may charge.
